Hebrews 12:25–29 ESV

²⁵See that you do not refuse him who is speaking. For if they did not escape when they refused him who warned them on earth, much less will we escape if we reject him who warns from heaven. ²⁶At that time his voice shook the earth, but now he has promised, “Yet once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens.” ²⁷This phrase, “Yet once more,” indicates the removal of things that are shaken—that is, things that have been made—in order that the things that cannot be shaken may remain. ²⁸Therefore let us be grateful for receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, and thus let us offer to God acceptable worship, with reverence and awe, ²⁹for our God is a consuming fire.

Numbers 11:1–3 ESV

¹And the people complained in the hearing of the LORD about their misfortunes, and when the LORD heard it, his anger was kindled, and the fire of the LORD burned among them and consumed some outlying parts of the camp. ²Then the people cried out to Moses, and Moses prayed to the LORD, and the fire died down. ³So the name of that place was called Taberah, because the fire of the LORD burned among them.

How Does the Wrath of God Relate to the Grace of God?

1. The Wrath of God Was, and Is, and Will Be Against _____
Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him. (John 3:36 ESV)

2. Jesus Christ _____ the Wrath of God on the Cross
For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus, whom God put forward as a propitiation by his blood, to be received by faith. (Romans 3:23–25 ESV)

And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come. (1 Thessalonians 1:10 ESV)

3. In Christ, We Are Under God's _____

⁵And have you forgotten the exhortation that addresses you as sons? "My son, do not regard lightly the discipline of the Lord, nor be weary when reproved by him. ⁶For the Lord disciplines the one he loves, and chastises every son whom he receives." ⁷It is for discipline that you have to endure. God is treating you as sons. For what son is there whom his father does not discipline? ⁸If you are left without discipline, in which all have participated, then you are illegitimate children and not sons. ⁹Besides this, we have had earthly fathers who disciplined us and we respected them. Shall we not much more be subject to the Father of spirits and live? ¹⁰For they disciplined us for a short time as it seemed best to them, but he disciplines us for our good, that we may share his holiness. ¹¹For the moment all discipline seems painful rather than pleasant, but later it yields the peaceful fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it. (Hebrews 12:5–11 ESV)

KINGDOM CAUSE FOR AUGUST

Our Kingdom Cause for August is Refugees. Recent United Nation's figures show that, on average, 44,000 people leave their homes due to conflict and persecution every day. Today, over 80 million people have been forced to leave their homes, creating a world crisis with 27 million refugees who have left their home country. The war with Russia has displaced over 5 million people in Ukraine. The Bible commands us, "When a stranger sojourns with you in your land, you shall not do him wrong. You shall treat the stranger who sojourns with you as the native among you, and you shall love him as yourself, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God" (Leviticus 19:33-34 ESV). To support our Kingdom Cause, you can **GIVE** to the Ukrainian Gospel Response Fund which helps our International Mission Board missionaries and their local partners minister to Ukrainians who are escaping the escalating conflict. You can also **SERVE** by joining the Good Neighbor Team, a group within our church that works with World Relief to walk alongside a refugee family that has been resettled in our community, to help them start their new life.
