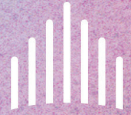

¹² **Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts, kindness,** humility, meekness, and patience, ¹³ bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. ¹⁴ And above all these put on love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. **Colossians 3:9–14 (ESV)**
