and saves the crushed in spirit.

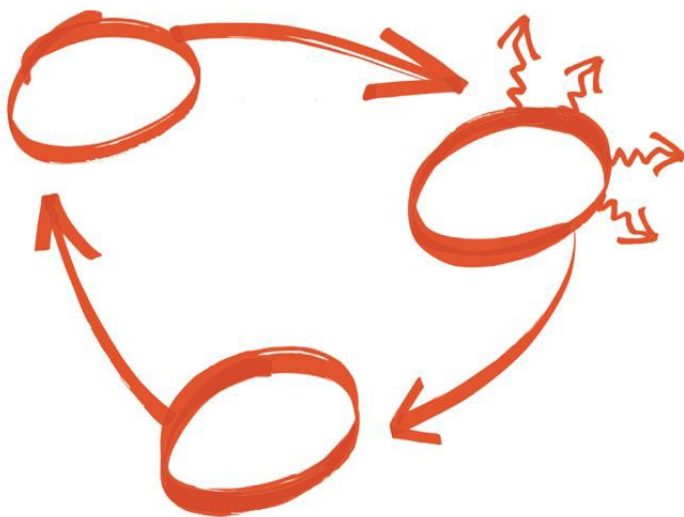
¹⁹ Many are the afflictions of the righteous,
