

⁶So we are always of good courage. We know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord, ⁷for we walk by faith, not by sight. ⁸Yes, we are of good courage, and we would rather be away from the body and at home with the Lord. ⁹So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please him. ¹⁰For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive what is due for what he has done in the body, whether good or evil.

¹⁷Let the elders who rule well be considered worthy of double honor, especially those who labor in preaching and teaching. ¹⁸For the Scripture says, "You shall not muzzle an ox when it treads out the grain," and, "The laborer deserves his wages." ¹⁹Do not admit a charge against an elder except on the evidence of two or three witnesses. ²⁰As for those who persist in sin, rebuke them in the presence of all, so that the rest may stand in fear. ²¹In the presence of God and of Christ Jesus and of the elect angels I charge you to keep these rules without prejudging, doing nothing from partiality. ²²Do not be hasty in the laying on of hands, nor take part in the sins of others; keep yourself pure. ²³(No longer drink only water, but use a little wine for the sake of your stomach and your frequent ailments.) ²⁴The sins of some people are conspicuous, going before them to judgment, but the sins of others appear later. ²⁵So also good works are conspicuous, and even those that are not cannot remain hidden.

Kingdom Cause for March

Our Kingdom Cause for the month of March is the refugee crisis. According to the United Nations, there are 103 million displaced people around the world today. While 53 million of these are displaced within their own country, there are over 32 million who are refugees. Refugees are people who have fled war, violence, conflict or other persecution and have crossed an international border to find safety in another country. As God's people, we are commanded to "love the sojourner (refugee)" (Deuteronomy 10.19). To that end, our partner agency is World Relief of North Texas.

For over 40 years, World Relief North Texas has come alongside refugees and other immigrants in vulnerable situations as they rebuild their lives in the United States. They work to empower the local church to walk alongside refugees and immigrants in the DFW area. They aim to tackle the world's greatest problems with holistic, locally-driven solutions that lead to lasting change.

Our church has a Good Neighbor Team that works with WRNT. We have been matched with a refugee family and are working to help them achieve stability in their new community. You can support the ministry to Refugees by donation to World Relief or by donating funds to our Good Neighbor team to help our refugee family.
