Q1 = Rabbi, when did You come here? (25)

²⁶Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you are seeking me, not because you saw _____, but because you ate your fill of the loaves. ²⁷Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his seal." (John 6:26–27 ESV)

Q2 = What must we do to be doing the works of God? (28)

Jesus answered them, "This is the work of God, that you _____ in him whom he has sent." (John 6:29 ESV)

Q3 = What sign do you do that we may see and believe you? (30)

For the bread of God is he who comes down from _____ and gives life to the world. (John 6:33 ESV)

Q4 = Then give us this bread always (34)

³⁵Jesus said to them, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me shall not hunger, and whoever believes in me shall never thirst. ³⁶But I said to you that you have seen me and yet do not believe. ³⁷All that the Father gives me will come to me, and whoever comes to me I will never cast out. ³⁸For I have come down from heaven, not to do my own will but the will of him who sent me. ³⁹And this is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day. ⁴⁰For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. (John 6:35–40 ESV)

Q5 = How does He say, "I have come down from heaven"? (41)

⁵⁰This is the bread that comes down from heaven, so that one may eat of it and not die. ⁵¹I am the _____ bread that came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever. And the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh. (John 6:50–51 ESV)

Q6 = How can this man give us His flesh to eat? (52)

⁵³So Jesus said to them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you. ⁵⁴Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day. ⁵⁵For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. ⁵⁶Whoever _____ on my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him. (John 6:53–56 ESV)

Q7 = This is a hard saying, who can listen to it? (60)

⁶¹Do you take offense at this? ⁶²Then what if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before? ⁶³It is the _____ who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life. (John 6:61–63 ESV)

Q8 = We can't follow You anymore (66)

⁶⁷So Jesus said to the twelve, "Do you want to go away as well?" ⁶⁸Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life, ⁶⁹and we have _____, and have come to know, that you are the Holy One of God." (John 6:67–69 ESV)
