THE GOSPEL OF JOHN RESURRECTION

1 Peter 1:8-9 ESV

Though you have not seen him, you love him. Though you do not now see him, you believe in him and rejoice with joy that is inexpressible and filled with glory, obtaining the outcome of your faith, the salvation of your souls.

John 20.19-29 ESV

¹⁹On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the doors being locked where the disciples were for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you." ²⁰When he had said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples were glad when they saw the Lord. ²¹Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you." ²²And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. ²³If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you withhold forgiveness from any, it is withheld."

²⁴Now Thomas, one of the twelve, called the Twin, was not with them when Jesus came. ²⁵So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see in his hands the mark of the nails, and place my finger into the mark of the nails, and place my hand into his side, I will never believe."

²⁶Eight days later, his disciples were inside again, and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." ²⁷Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side. Do not disbelieve, but believe." ²⁸Thomas answered him, "My Lord and my God!" ²⁹Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

²⁵"These things I have spoken to you while I am still with you. ²⁶But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you. ²⁷Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Christian Community Assistance (CCA) is an interdenominational ministry serving our Fort Worth neighbors since 1989.

Their primary mission is to provide services for Fort Worth residents living in poverty, treating every client with respect, value and Christ-like compassion. Their

services include a food pantry and clothing closet. They work in partnership with churches, individuals, organizations (including Tarrant Area Food Bank) and their many volunteers, the driving force behind their mission.

We can join CCA in their ministry in three ways. First, we can **volunteer** our time. They are open Mondays, Thursdays, and Fridays from 9 to 1 and ask for volunteers to work four hour shifts.

Second, we can **donate** gently used clothes and food. Their greatest need right now are unopened packages of socks and underwear, pinto beans (canned or dried), canned fruit, and toilet paper. Donations can be left in the church office during the month of March.
